ABOUT THE COMPETITION

Spacing magazine invites architects, urban planners, landscape architects, designers, graphic artists, students, and the urban curious — 35 years old or younger — to take part in **thinkToronto**, an urban design ideas competition that will help celebrate the magazine's 5th anniversary in December 2008. **thinkToronto** seeks ideas from the next generation of city builders who want to challenge how we view Toronto's public realm. The competition gives participants a platform to explore and experiment with Toronto's urban landscape and generate a dialogue among Torontonians about creative and sustainable solutions in our shared common spaces.

WHAT TYPE OF SUBMISSIONS WE'RE LOOKING FOR:

There are three types of categories to enter:

- **Streetscape Elements:** Redesign or propose new pieces of infrastructure or street furniture that dot the roads and sidewalks of Toronto.
- **Specific Area Design:** Address a problem or challenge that is located in a specific area or neighbourhood of Toronto.
- **General Entry:** Submissions can be of anything that is located in Toronto's public realm such as a re-design of an intersection, a new way to irrigate street trees, or a new form of mass transit.

- A gallery exhibit will follow competition
